

CIRQUE DU SOLEIL



Melbourne, April 18th 2007

The Cirque du Soleil performed in Auckland from Dec 28, 2006 to Feb 20, 2007. The circus relied for all its electricity on two Caterpillar XQ1500kW gensets, one of which was used at any one time to provide power to the site including performances and the other kept on standby as a backup. A third smaller Caterpillar XQ300 genset was used for night time power.

All three gensets were operated on B20 biodiesel blends supplied by BP Oil New Zealand Limited for which the biodiesel component was tallow methyl ester. A total of 120 000 liters of B20 was used during this time.

BP later supplied a test report for both the biodiesel and the B20 blend which demonstrated that the biodiesel and the blend met the New Zealand Standard for biodiesel, NZS 7500:2005.

We enjoyed a trouble free run on this fuel and no problems with the gensets have emerged since which could be attributed to this fuel.
